Comprehensive psychological assessment (including risk assessment and psychometric assessment) and treatment for children and young people from the Child Protection and Out of Home Care system, who presented with high a complex needs (i.e. intellectual disabilities, significant mental health and behavioural concerns, including early psychosis, self-harm, suicidal behaviours, aggressive behaviours, sexualized behaviours, drug and alcohol use, frequent absconding, offending behaviours), all presenting with significant trauma and abuse histories. I was also engaged in writing Court reports on a regular basis for submission to the Supreme Court, District Court, Family Court, and Children’s Courts.
- **Specialist Psychologist – Marist Youth Care (Out of Home Care/Residential Care Agency): May 2009 – March 2012**  
Comprehensive psychological assessments and treatment for children/young people who presented with high and complex needs with significant trauma and abuse histories, living in the Out of Home Care system. Design, implement, and train staff in comprehensive behaviour support plans for all young people living within Marist Youth Care. Training and support of staff and carers working with children and young people in MYC.
